Shower Voucher Resource List

1. PURPOSE:

Clients receiving services from the Broomfield Department of Human Services (DHS), its non-profit partner agencies, and shower resource agencies may at times need access to shower facilities at Broomfield Recreation Centers. This document specifies the roles of agency partners and the procedure for usage of shower vouchers to use the facilities for that purpose only for free.

2. PROCEDURE:

- <u>Vouchers</u> shall be made available by Broomfield Recreation Services staff to DHS, DHS non-profit grantees, and agencies who provide shower resources (please see comprehensive list of eligible entities below).

 - Which agency is distributing the voucher
 - Agency staff member authorizing the usage
 - Date issued
 - First name of the client receiving the voucher
 - Voucher information must be complete to be accepted
 - Vouchers should be printed in color.
 - Vouchers must be used within 30 days of issuance (exceptions may be made at the discretion of the rec center).
 - Clients should follow the hours and instructions for usage on the voucher.
